NON-EXCLUSIVE PERMISSIONS:

By entering this art competition you are granting the Chartiers Creek Watershed Association (ChCWA) a non-exclusive, perpetual license to reproduce images of your artwork on our website, in our newsletters, and in the marketing of the art competition to the general public. Artworks will not be used for any other purpose than that which is stated here. All winning entries will be displayed on the ChCWA website. They can be removed at a later date upon request. ChCWA is not responsible if a third party should duplicate or print the artwork without our consent.

PARAMETERS FOR ARTWORK:

1. **THEME** – All entries should reflect the theme “Water: Can Science Save It?” and represent the student’s perception, interpretation or vision of this theme.
2. **NO NAMES** – Please do not put your name anywhere on your entry, to ensure anonymity during the judging.
3. **SCHOOL APPROPRIATE** – All entries must meet school guidelines regarding offensive text or imagery.
4. **PUBLIC DISPLAY** – All entries must be suitable for display in a public space over a period of weeks...
 - Please do not use any potentially dangerous materials or materials that will break down over time
 - Neither ChCWA nor the Frank Sarris Library is responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged entries.
5. **ORIGINALITY** – Artwork must be the original work of the student. Original work is created by the student and shows a fresh, new perspective or idea.
6. **ENTRY FORM** – To enter this contest, you and your parents/guardians must fill out the Entry Form in this packet.
7. **RECLAIM YOUR WORK** – All artwork must be claimed by the artist on Saturday February 17, 2018 at the Frank Sarris Library. If you are unable to do so, please email ChCWA at the address below to make alternate arrangements on or before Saturday March 3, 2018. Any artwork not claimed by the artist by Saturday March 3, 2018 may be disposed of at the discretion of the ChCWA board.
